School Supplies 2018-2019

Below is a list of the school supplies you will need to purchase for your child/children will need in September in addition to the items you paid for through FACTS. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS OR BINDERS ARE PERMITTED. Each child in grades K-2 needs a headset for computer class similar to those offered by "Leapfrog." They must be sturdy and made to fit small heads. The cost is \$14.95 on Amazon.com. Students may also opt to rent headsets from the school for \$5.00. The school will provide some supplies for grades K-3 from the supply fee paid through FACTS: homework assignment books (grs. K,1,2,3), specially lined copybooks and loose leaf paper, pencil pouch (if needed-please note: three no box pencil cases are allowed). Scholastic, Explaining God's Word, Art fee. The school will provide two communication folders to each child in grades K – 5 with no charge.
