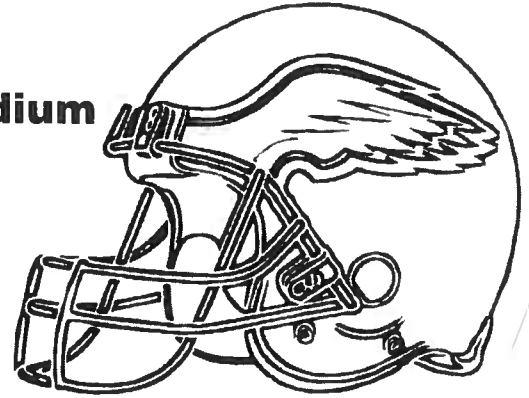

Happy Holidays! This is the time of the school year when parents often notice their children losing motivation. How can parents determine if the lack of motivation is attributed to the season or something more?

CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING...

- Is the lack of motivation situation-specific or across the board?
 - In one subject or multiple subjects?
 - At home, school or both?
 - In social settings?

- Talk to your child without judgement
 - Encourage them to freely explain what is going on
 - Can they elaborate or are they at a loss?
 - Ask open-endedly: "How can we help?"

- Consider rewards initially to increase drive
- Develop achievable goals with your child
- Determine if they are on grade-level or need additional assistance
- Consider tutoring or emotional/behavior supports
