Autumn Auction: An annual fun-filled event held each Autumn where attendees participate in basket raffle/drawings which includes items that range from approximately \$50 to over \$1,000. These items are generously donated from school families and local community businesses. The Early Bird admission fee of \$30.00 includes a starter pack of raffle tickets, water, dessert and coffee. Please feel free to bring your own “munchies” and beverages. Tickets at the door are \$35.00

The starter pack of raffle tickets includes 20 yellow tickets, 5 orange tickets and 2 red tickets. Additional tickets may be purchased as follows:

Color Designations

Approximate Basket Value

Yellow: 20 tickets = \$10.00

Under \$100; level 1-on yellow tables

Orange: 5 tickets = \$10.00

\$100-\$199; level 2-on orange tables

Green: 3 tickets = \$10.00

\$200-\$299; level 3-on green tables

Red: \$5 each or 5 tickets for \$20.00

\$300-\$399; level 4-on red tables

Ivory: \$10 each or 3 tickets for \$20.00

Over \$400; level 5-on ivory tables

50/50 tickets will be on sale for 3/\$5; 7/\$10; 20/\$20; 75 for \$50.00. Credit cards will be accepted.

5:30-7:00 PM Inspect baskets, enjoy munchies/beverages and purchase tickets.

Drawing of Level 1 basket winners will begin at 7:00 PM

There will be a 15 minute intermission after drawing of Level 2 baskets

Drawing of Level 5 baskets should conclude around 9:30 to 10:00 PM

Families will earn fund-raising credit of 50% per admission ticket purchased/sold by that family. Also, families will earn fund-raising credit of 100% for items donated. Please-new items only and please present a receipt, if possible. It is the responsibility of the families to let the Chairpersons know what they have donated and the value in kind amount.
